MOBILE RESPONSE AND IMMEDIATE STABILIZATION SERVICES

Services provided to you in your home to ease an immediate crisis and provide support:

- Minimize the impact of the crisis on you and your family
- Create plans to ensure safety
- Connect you and your family to other helpful resources

ADDITIONAL STABILIZATION SERVICES

Short-term services may be provided in addition to mobile response for 6-8 weeks to help ensure your family's long-term success:

- Teach skills to improve family functioning
- Create plans that prepare you for and prevent future crisis
- Prevent the need for out-of-home services
- Arm you with ongoing resources and support





Stabilization & Mobile Response Services may help a child who:

- Has difficulties in school
- Is verbally or physically aggressive
- Bullies or is bullied
- Often runs away
- Uses substances
- Destroys or steals property
- Threatens to inflict harm upon self or others
- Is withdrawn from friends or peers
- Experiences depression or anxiety
- Demonstrates severe changes in mood

Stabilization and Mobile Response services are free, available 24/7, and provide support in times of crisis.


